Getting started

- A computer with stable internet connection OR
- A mobile device if you choose to join using this technology
- Headphones or quality speakers
- A Chrome or Firefox browser (recommended)

Joining the AGM

You will be able to login to the online AGM portal using the link provided in your confirmation email or reminder email.

After you have successfully registered, you will receive a series of emails to keep you updated, including a confirmation email which will contain the link to join the online Meeting.

The online portal will be open 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start time of the AGM.

To ask a question at the AGM click on the 'Live Q&A' tab




and type your question into the relevant section and click submit. The questions will be addressed at the appropriate time during the AGM.
